Celebrant The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all.

People **And also with you.**

Presentation and Examination of the Candidate

Celebrant The candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

When the candidate is unable to answer for himself, he is presented by his parents and sponsors as follows:

Parents and Sponsors **We present Oliver George to receive the sacrament of baptism.**

Celebrant Will you be responsible for seeing that Oliver who you present is nurtured in the faith and life of the Christian community?

Parents and Sponsors **I will, with God's help.**

Celebrant Will you by your prayers and witness help Oliver to grow into the full stature of Christ?

Parents and Sponsors **I will, with God's help.**

Then the celebrant asks the following questions of the parents and sponsors who speak on behalf of Oliver.

Question Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Answer **I renounce them.**

Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

I renounce them.

Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

I renounce them.

Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Saviour?

I do.

Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

I do.

Do you promise to obey him as your Lord?

I do.

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Oliver and his family in their life in Christ?

The Baptism

The Celebrant asks the parents to name the child.

Celebrant Oliver George, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

The celebrant makes the sign of the cross on the forehead using chrism

Celebrant I sign you with the cross, and mark you as Christ's own for ever.

The celebrant prays over the newly baptized, saying,

Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon your servant the forgiveness of sin, and have raised him to the new life of grace. Sustain Oliver, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give him an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works.

The Giving of the Light

Celebrant Oliver, receive the light of Christ, to show that you have passed from darkness to light.

People **Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.**

Let us welcome the newly baptized.

We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.
