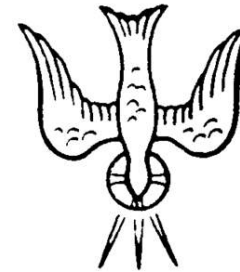

Originally founded in 1975, the choir has made a number of recordings. The choir also performs regularly at hospitals and nursing homes.
